

Community Development & Reconciliation Projects



Central Africa Reconciliation, peace-building, community development. With a strategy of organizing more than 7,000 local intercessors who are being actively discipled and trained in basic counselling (Cure d'Ame) and community development, this "movement" has directly impacted hundreds of thousands, seeing them healed physically, emotionally and spiritually.

East Africa - Healing & Reconciliation for Sustainable Peace and Development. Using a workshop called "Healing the Wounds of Ethnic Conflict" this small team has helped entire communities become whole again, bridging tribal suspicions and enabling them to maintain peace even in the onslaught of ongoing political turmoil.

Central Africa - Reconciliation and Community Transformation.

Using a multi-faceted approach of workshops, radio messages, song, paintings, training seminars and a Bible school, they train pastors and youth to become agents of Biblical transformation in their communities. They have run many reconciliation workshops in prisons for the genocide perpetrators who are due to be released soon and will have to re-integrate into society after more than 20 years in prison.

Asia - Integrated Rural Development (Micro-enterprise). This team seeks to improve community quality of life through training in animal husbandry, nutrition, and running family businesses. Cooperatives are encouraged and micro-credit is provided.



Southern Africa - Orphan and Community

Transformation. This project finished working in one of its original targeted communities by the end of 2017 with phenomenal success. People have abandoned their animist spiritism and many have come to rely on God. They have declared themselves a "Christian community where animistic practices are no longer acceptable!" Household income has increased so many can now support their families, drinking and production water have become more widely available, education is better than it has been for years and orphans are being looked after by the community.

Over 9 million

people are impacted annually by these locally-run projects. We serve them in their efforts by assisting in writing proposals, making donor reports, facilitating strategic planning sessions, doing debriefing and a wide range of training or consulting on the field with them.
